HEALTH INSURANCE

La Crosse County offers you the choice of two different preferred provider organization (PPO) health insurance programs. A PPO is a network or group of health care providers that provide health care services at a reduced cost. The employee can still choose to go to a health care provider who is not part of the network, but would pay more. This is unlike an HMO (health maintenance organization) where you cannot have health coverage paid for if you go outside the network.

If you work half time or more in a regular position (not limited term or contract), you may be eligible for health insurance coverage.

MAYO CLINIC HEALTH SYSTEMS (MCHS)

Deductible Option - This option provides 90% coverage after a \$100 deductible on medically necessary care when using the in-network providers of Mayo Clinic Health Systems.

Prescription Coverage - The Mayo Clinic Health Systems PPO provides a prescription card through a company called Innoviant. When used at an in-network pharmacy you will pay \$10 co-pay for generic, \$25 co-pay for formulary brand drugs and \$45 for non-formulary drugs. Maintenance drugs may be purchased through the mail with 2 co-pays for a 100 day supply. Contact customer service with any questions at 1-877-559-2955.

Plan Administrators – Mayo Management Systems Inc (MMSI) of Rochester MN administers this plan. If you select this plan, you will receive a Medical and a Prescription ID card by your effective date.

When used at an in-network pharmacy you will pay \$10 co-pay for generic, \$25 co-pay for formulary brand drugs and \$45 for non-formulary drugs.
