WISCONSIN RETIREMENT SYSTEM

BASIC PLAN INFORMATION

This plan has been rated as one of the top retirement plans in the U.S. It is based in Madison, Wisconsin.

HOW THE PLAN WORKS

As of the hire date, eligible employees are automatically enrolled. To be eligible for the plan, employees must be in a regular position (not limited term, contract, less than half time, or on call). Under the 2011 Wisconsin Act 10, employees are required to pay 50% of the contribution to the retirement plan. The required contribution will be deducted from the gross pay. (Note that certain law enforcement positions are not covered by Act 10 and may have different contribution requirements.) New hires can choose to participate in either the fixed or the variable fund.

ANNUAL STATEMENT

You will get an annual statement of how much money you have in the fund. The statements generally come out in May for the preceding year. *Be sure to save this important document with your important papers.*
