**The County Board of Supervisors of La Crosse County does ordain as follows:**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND S. 2.01(2) ENTITLED "SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS"  
OF THE GENERAL CODE OF LA CROSSE COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

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**ANALYSIS**

The La Crosse County Final Supervisory District Plan reduces the number of supervisory districts from 35 to 29 in La Crosse County. The numbering and boundaries of each supervisory district are illustrated on the certified map that will be permanently on file in the County Clerk's office. The statutory timeline has passed for ward creation by the local municipalities with the latest possible deadline being July 21, 2011. The State has advised all county clerks that counties are in the last statutory 60 day time frame to finalize a supervisory district plan which must be received by the Wisconsin Legislature by September 19, 2011.

The ideal district population for the 29 supervisory districts is 3,953 resulting in 13 supervisors representing the City of La Crosse and 16 supervisors representing the remainder of the county.

The Final Supervisory District Plan meets the guiding principles for redistricting in that the Supervisory Districts are substantially equal in population, compact, respect communities of interest and when possible, retain the core of existing districts. The county clerk shall file with the Secretary of State a certified copy of the redistricting plan enacted by the County Board.

The Final Supervisory District Plan will initially be applicable to the election of County Board Supervisors commencing in 2012 with the first election under this plan to be held on the first Tuesday in April, 2012. The supervisors that are elected shall take office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday in April of that year.

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**INFORMATION:**

County Board Rules: Governing Body s. 2.02(8) states, in part: Ordinances are drafted by the Corporation Counsel. After the ordinance has been reviewed by a standing committee, each Supervisor will be given a copy of the ordinance showing the deleted language (grayed) and the new language (underlined) and an analysis of the intent of the ordinance. After introduction to the County Board, the ordinance shall be referred to the next monthly meeting unless waived by a 2/3 vote of the Supervisors present and a public hearing may be held if requested by a Supervisor. An amendment may be introduced and debated at either the original or the referred meeting. **AN ORDINANCE #96 - 9/11**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND S. 2.01(2) ENTITLED "SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS"  
OF THE GENERAL CODE OF LA CROSSE COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of La Crosse does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 2.01(2) is amended to read:

2.01(2) Supervisory Districts. The County Board adopts the "La Crosse County Final Supervisory District Plan" that creates 29 supervisory districts and is illustrated by a certified map of the same title that shall be permanently on file with the County Clerk. The Supervisory Districts of La Crosse County shall be numbered and bound as follows:

1. FIRST SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 1 and 2.
2. SECOND SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 3 and 5.
3. THIRD SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 4 and 6.
4. FOURTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 9 and 12.
5. FIFTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 8 and 11.
6. SIXTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 7 and 10.
7. SEVENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 19 and 21.
8. EIGHTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 13, 15, 17, and 18.
9. NINTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 14 and 16.
10. TENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse - Wards 20, 23, and 24.

11. ELEVENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse – Wards 22 and 27.
12. TWELFTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse – Wards 25 and 26.
13. THIRTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of La Crosse – Wards 28 and 29.
14. FOURTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Town of Campbell – Wards 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
15. FIFTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Town of Campbell – Ward 1; Town of Onalaska – Ward 8; and City of Onalaska – Wards 1 and 5.
16. SIXTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of Onalaska – Wards 4, 6, and 7.
17. SEVENTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of Onalaska – Wards 8, 9, and 10.
18. EIGHTEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of Onalaska – Wards 11 and 12; Town of Medary – Ward 1; and Town of Onalaska – Ward 4.
19. NINETEENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
City of Onalaska – Wards 2 and 3; and Town of Onalaska – Ward 3.
20. TWENTIETH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Village of Holmen – Wards 6, 7, 8, and 10; and Town of Onalaska – Ward 2.
21. TWENTY-FIRST SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Village of Holmen – Wards 9 and 11; and Town of Onalaska – Wards 5, 6, and 7.
22. TWENTY-SECOND SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Village of Holmen – Wards 2, 3, 4, and 5; and Town of Holland – Ward 1.
23. TWENTY-THIRD SUPERVISORY DISTRICT  
Village of Holmen – Ward 1; and Town of Holland – Wards 2, 3, 4 and 5.

24. TWENTY-FOURTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Town of Onalaska - Wards 1; Town of Holland - Ward 6; Town of Hamilton - Ward 1; and Town of Farmington - Wards 1 and 2.

25. TWENTY-FIFTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Village of West Salem - Wards 1, 2, 4, and 5; and Town of Hamilton - Ward 3.

26. TWENTY-SIXTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Town of Hamilton - Ward 2; Town of Burns - Ward 1; Town of Bangor - Ward 1; Village of Bangor - Wards 1 and 2; and Village of Rockland - Ward 1.

27. TWENTY-SEVENTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Town of Barre - Ward 1; Town of Hamilton - Ward 5; Town of Greenfield - Wards 1 and 2; and Town of Washington - Ward 1.

28. TWENTY-EIGHTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Village of West Salem - Wards 3 and 6; Town of Barre - Ward 2; Town of Hamilton - Ward 4; Town of Medary - Ward 2; and Town of Shelby - Ward 4.


29. TWENTY-NINTH SUPERVISORY DISTRICT

Town of Shelby - Wards 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6.

**Section 3.** Initial applicability: This ordinance shall be first applied to the election to be held on the first Tuesday in April, 2012, any spring primary required for such election, and each subsequent election.


