The La Crosse County Planning, Resources and Development Committee, having considered the application filed by:



and having held a public hearing on the 28 <sup>th</sup> day of FEBRUARY 2011 for a Conditional Use Permit to		
excavate and sell borrow materials from an approximate ½ acre site along the north side of Loging Road		
on land that is zoned <u>EXCLUSIVE AGRICULTURE DISTRICT</u> in the Town(s) of <u>BARRE</u>		
on land described as follows: The South 25' of the East 400' of the SW-SE of Section 16, T16N, R6W, and that part of the NW-NE of Section 21, T16N, R6W lying northerly of Loging Rd; EXCEPT that part lying easterly of the private driveway. Town of Barre.		
And pursuant to s. 59.69 Wis. Stats. and s. 17.36 Zoning Code: the Committee did publish and receive proof of a Class II notice of the hearing; did receive receipts of mailing of the notices to the affected Town Clerk(s); did hold a public hearing to hear testimony or correspondence from the people; and, did receive and consider action from the affected Town Board(s). The Committee, under s. 91.48(1), Wis. Stats., along with the affected Town Board(s), under s. 17.36(4), have the authority to approve the application with integral conditions or to disapprove of the application. Having considered the entire record the Committee's recommendation is to: <b>Approve with conditions</b> .		
By a vote of five $(\underline{5})$ in favor (two $(\underline{2})$ excused – Keil & Manthei) the Committee recommended approval subject to the following six $(\underline{6})$ conditions:		
<ol> <li>This permit is granted to allow the removal of borrow materials with no stockpiling. If more than one (1 acre is disturbed an after-the-fact Non-Metallic Mining Permit will be required;</li> <li>Access to this site is from the private driveway – no access is allowed onto Loging Rd;</li> <li>Nothing can be taken from the right-of-way of Loging Rd unless specifically approved by the Town Board including ditching and final sloping;</li> <li>An approved erosion control permit is required before any borrow materials are removed;</li> <li>This permit expires the end of September 2012; and</li> <li>This permit is non-transferable.</li> </ol>
