RE: OPPOSITION TO THE CLOSURE OF THE USPS PROCESSING CENTER IN LA CROSSE

WHEREAS, the U.S. Postal Service has recently announced its decision to close the La Crosse mail processing center in an effort to consolidate services; and,

WHEREAS, closure of this facility could result in the loss of 27 local jobs and transfer another 19 local positions to the Twin Cities; and,

WHEREAS, closure of this facility would also eliminate next day mail service, resulting in 2 to 3 day delivery of local mail within the City of La Crosse and surrounding area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the La Crosse County Board of Supervisors hereby expresses its opposition to the USPS decision to close the Mail Processing Center at La Crosse, Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be mailed to Postmaster General Patrick Donahoe, U.S. Senator Ron Johnson, U.S. Senator Herb Kohl and Rep. Ron Kind, requesting that they be encouraged to do whatever is possible to keep this processing center open..
