Linda Young nominates Sue Tiry for Planning Committee Chair. Mary Johnson seconds. Passed all in favor.

Sue calls the meeting to order.

Committee reviews language in the Transportation Plan starting on Page 27.

Language throughout the plan will be changed from “extra territorial zoning” to “plat approval”. The following will be added to the last paragraph of the land use plan (page 29):

“Following a review of Extraterritorial Zoning vs. Extraterritorial Plat Approval, the Village of Rockland’s Planning Committee, with input from the attending Village Board member, decided on extra territorial plat approval as the more efficient option of accomplishing the defined purpose of this land use plan.”

Karl suggests that the Village Engineer review the Utility section of the final draft to make sure it is accurate.

Linda and Ann attended the October DOT meeting concerning the Weigh Station issue.

“Welcome to Rockland” banners and hardware were delivered to the Village Hall. They could be installed after the holiday decorations are down.

Discussion about future interstate access. The potential for interstate access is noted in the transportation of the plan.

Sue has typed the transportation plan with updates compiled the survey results. Linda will give the Village Board a copy of the community survey results at the December meeting.

Discussion of quorum requirements and meeting regulations. Discussion of what constitutes a gathering as a meeting. We reviewed reference materials from UW-Extension.
