

Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (CORP)

The public hearing for the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan was held at the Town Hall

W7052 Second Street, Onalaska, WI 54650 on Tuesday, September 28, 2010.

Schreiber Anderson and Associates Staff Reed Dunbar presented a power point on the DRAFT of the "Town of Onalaska Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (CORP)" i.e. Park Audit of Town Parks.

Sixteen citizens signed in for the hearing.

The Plan is a requirement if the town wants to apply for stewardship funding monies. Stewardship funds require a 50% match.

The Town has adequate number of mini and neighborhood parks, but is low on community Parks which are larger and offer more choices for activities.

Some recommendations were

1. Uniform signage for parks and identifying them as Town Parks
2. Replace/remove old outdated play equipment
3. Add soccer nets in smaller parks to attract teens. The town has no soccer nets or fields.

The Park Committee will meet to prioritize what should be done first.

Public hearing was adjourned at 6:52 pm.
