CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 11:40 a.m.

APPROVAL OF JUNE 9, 2010 MINUTES OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE MANAGEMENT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The June 9, 2010 CJMC Executive Committee minutes were approved as submitted.

PUBLIC COMMENT

WOMEN'S COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAM REPORT

Jane distributed the Women's Community Based Program June 2010 update, and the Program's overall report which incorporated this committee's suggestions. This report was given to the HHS Board and will also go to the CJMC next week. Jane pointed out that in 2008, we had 5 women who were sentenced; in 2009 there were 18; and 2010 there were 13. Jane also pointed out what the snapshot of the participants looked like.

NIC APPLICATION

Jane distributed the application that she will be sending out today to the NIC. We probably won't know until August whether or not we get this grant. The technical assistance application covers "Evidenced Based Decision Making" and is intended to provide education and training throughout the criminal justice system. Related to the technical assistance application, the DOC is involved in a pilot COMPASS project and is involved in motivational interviewing with their staff. Justice Sanctions will switch over to COMPASS from the LSI so would like to be included in the training. Bill Hammes will do a short demo of the COMPASS program for the CJMC. Jane feels that whether or not we get this grant, we still need to do training on evidence based practices to everyone in the system. One of the points that this system is based on is the fact that every person in the system has an opportunity to affect the defendant's behavior – so we all need to be on the same page. Judge Perlich will be talking to the Board of Directors of the Bar Association later this month to get their endorsement of this training. Jane will make copies of the workbook so we have a guide on how to get this done and to aid in our future discussions. The committee felt it was important that Bob Lawrence from the City Police attend these meetings, so we will invite him to come to this committee.

MISCELLANEOUS

Jane ran some data for us on the AIM data in February 2009. The Committee felt that this was interesting data in following trends, so Jane will run and distribute every 6 months.
