Wildlife Damage Program: January

1) Shooting Permit Harvest Exemption: *consideration*

Ted Dovenberg

- Issued WM-40 shooting permit on January 18, 2011
- Harvest Objective = 15 deer (80% harvest quota by September 15th = 12)
- Actual Harvest by Sept. 15th = 8 deer

Recommendation: *Based on confusion regarding an increased harvest quota from preceding years (Mr. Dovenberg believed his 80% quota was 8 deer, which he met) and his previous shooting permit performance, DNR and WS would recommend granting a harvest exemption.*

On January 27, 2012 the gray wolf was officially delisted from the Endangered Species Act. On that date, Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin took over management of the species (assumes no future litigation)???
