

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING FOR LA CROSSE COUNTY
MULTI-USE TRAIL AND BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE**

La Crosse County is proposing to construct a multi-use trail located along the southeast side of STH 16 from the S. Kinney Coulee Road intersection to the Landfill Road intersection in the City of Onalaska (Sections 1, 11, & 12, T16N, R7W). A new multi-use trail will also be constructed along the south side of STH 16, from County VP westward to the existing trail terminal with a new pedestrian bridge over the La Crosse River, in the Village of West Salem (Section 05, T16N, R06W).

The proposed project involves approximately 1.5 miles of new multi-use trail in the City of Onalaska and an additional 0.3 miles of trail with a new bicycle/pedestrian bridge over the La Crosse River in the Village of West Salem. Project construction is scheduled for the summer of 2023.
