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County XX Roadway Reconditioning to be discussed March 30th

Public informational meeting to be held by the La Crosse County
Highway Department

The planned roadway reconditioning project (located in Sections 18 & 19, T17N, R7W, Town of Onalaska, Sections 13 & 14, T17N, R8W, Town of Onalaska, Sections 2, 3, & 11, T17N, R8W, Town of Holland, and Sections 34 & 35, T18N, R8W, Town of Holland, La Crosse County, Wisconsin) will be discussed at a public information meeting on Thursday, March 30th, 2023, the La Crosse County Highway Department announced today.

The meeting will be held from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM at the Holland Town Hall, located at W7937 County Road MH, Holmen, WI 54636.

La Crosse County is proposing to reconstruct and realign the CTH XX/ CTH OT intersection, reconstruct CTH XX through New Amsterdam including curb and gutter, and recondition (pulverize and relay existing pavement) approximately 5.1 miles of roadway. Culvert pipes/drainage structures will be replaced, and drainage/ditching will be improved throughout the project limits. CTH XX will be closed to through traffic during construction operations. As part of this project a right of way plat has been prepared and some strip right of way and temporary easements will be required. Construction is currently planned for the 2025 construction season.

The March 30th meeting will begin with a short presentation at 4:00 PM followed by an open house format with a variety of exhibits and maps available for review. Representatives from Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc. and La Crosse County will be

on hand to answer questions about the roadway improvements. MSA Professional Services will also be in attendance to discuss the upcoming real estate acquisition process. Attendees will have the option of making written or verbal comments during the gathering.
