

WRAPAROUND TEAMS

CCS facilitates recovery through a wraparound team approach called **Coordinated Services Team (CST)** that brings together the consumer's support system.

This wraparound team includes the consumer, service facilitator, mental health professional, service providers, and other individuals chosen by the consumer (family, friends, etc). This team meets at least monthly to ensure success.

COORDINATED SERVICES TEAM (CST)

- Strengths-based and driven by a shared set of core values: family centered, outcome oriented, culturally responsive, and community based with individualized planning and development of natural supports
- Provides families access to needed supports and services and ownership of their own plan
- A team approach to respond to consumers with multiple needs
- Services that are supported through collaborative efforts of both formal and informal supports
