COVID-19 Public Health Emergency	Economic Support (ES)	The next deadline for 60-day notice of the federal public health emergency (PHE) ending is mid-August. Once the public health emergency ends, states will have 12-14 months to review eligibility for their current Medicaid recipients. During the PHE, states received additional federal matching funds for not involuntarily disenrolling residents from Medicaid. Wisconsin's Medicaid caseload grew substantially during the COVID-19 public health emergency. From December 2019 to September 2021, the Medicaid caseload increased by 41.56%.
