Our community continues to have a low positivity rate and we are not in outbreak. Visits are encouraged! Just a few reminders to make sure our visits are safe for our residents, several of which have not been fully vaccinated yet.

We need all visitors to:

- Continue to schedule all visits
- Going directly to the visitation location (generally the resident's private room) and remaining in the designated visitation space for the duration of your visit
- Maintaining social distance throughout the visit unless the resident you are visiting is fully vaccinated
- Practicing good hand hygiene
- Wearing a well-fitted surgical face mask for the entire visit
- Only having two visitors per visit
