

# EROSION CONTROL PERMIT FEES

## Effective January 1, 2023

CATEGORY	FEES
<b>A</b>	\$ 250.00
<b>B</b> < 1 acre	\$ 300.00
> 1 acre	\$ 400.00
<b>C</b> < 1 acre	\$ 500.00
> 1 acre	\$ 1,000.00
<b>D - Logging Roads only</b>	\$ 150.00
<b>Subdivisions and Condominium Plats with Multi-family Dwellings</b>	\$1,000 + \$50/ proposed lot or unit. No fees will be charged for outlots.
<b>Condominium Plats with 1 &amp; 2 Family Dwellings (UDC)</b>	Review Fees for plat determined by use of Standard Categories. Each individual building will require a separate permit per UDC based on standard categories.
<b>After-the-fact</b> fees and re-submittal fees shall be based on Ch. 21.19	
<b>Non-compliance Inspection Fee</b>	50% of the permit fee per visit
<b>Escrow Account or Surety Bonds</b> shall be based on Ch. 21.12(5)	

**1. All of the following must apply to a site to qualify as a Category A:**

- Land disturbance in areas with slopes less than 12%
- Land disturbance less than 20,000 sq. ft.
- Excavation and /or fill less than 1,000 cubic yards
- Land Disturbance will not occur within the Shoreland Zones

**If any of the above DO NOT apply, continue:**

**2. All of the following must apply to a site to qualify as a Category B:**

- Land disturbance in areas with slopes less than 20%
- Land Disturbance will not occur within the Shoreland Zones

**If any of the above DO NOT apply, the site is a Category C**

21.12 (1)(e) Category Changes. The Department or its designee may reduce the category of the plan if the land disturbance activity is determined to have minimal off-site erosion potential.
