What is Commingled Recycling?

Also known as "Dual Stream Recycling", commingling is the process of separating fibers (cardboard, office paper, newspaper, etc.) from rigids (soda cans, tins/steels, glass, plastics and cartons). This process is seen to be more cost effective and leads to lower contamination rates.
