**Observed Violations - 10 - Internal roadways**

**OBSERVATION:** Campground road system observed to be muddy with deep ruts in ground.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Maintain or grade roadway (s) to provide drainage. Correct By: 04-Oct-2019

**CODE CITATION:** ATCP 79.12 (2) ROADWAYS. All roads within the campground shall be graded and maintained to provide drainage.

**Observed Violations - 11 - Distance separation-after effective date**

**OBSERVATION:** A minimum 10 ft separation distance is not provided at multiple locations throughout campground.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Provide a minimum 10 foot separation distance measured from the outside edge of one camping unit to the outside edge of another camping unit, excluding slideouts. Camping unit property, such as camping unit porches, decks, sheds within 10 feet of a camping unit shall be considered part of the camping unit for the purposes of determining distance separation. Correct By: 04-Oct-2019

**CODE CITATION:** ATCP 79.13 (1) DISTANCE SEPARATION REQUIREMENTS. (a) Distance requirement.

1. The operator shall require a minimum distance of 10 feet between camping units measured from the outside edge of one camping unit to the outside edge of another camping unit, excluding slideouts.
2. Except as provided in par. (b), any accessory within 10 feet of a camping unit such as, but not limited to, a deck or storage shed shall be considered part of the camping unit for the purposes of determining distance separation.
3. Except as provided in par. (b), or unless otherwise specified in this chapter, a campground building other than a camping unit shall be a minimum of 10 feet away from a camping unit.

**Observed Violations - 58 - Waste from recreational vehicles-transfer or holding tank maintenance**

**OBSERVATION:** Transfer or holding tank is not provided to receive waste valve, observed open running into ground.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Provide and maintain transfer or holding tank in good condition and leak-proof or maintain waste pipe and closed valve. Correct By: 04-Oct-2019

**CODE CITATION:** ATCP 79.15 (3) WASTE FROM RECREATIONAL VEHICLES. (c) Transfer tanks and holding tanks shall be maintained in good condition and be leak-proof.

**Comments:**

Discussed splitters connected to water supplies.

Contact department to discuss: Legible site numbers, designating independent vs dependent campsites, written plans to address campsite density per acre, plans to maintain electrical system.

Discussed fire containment enforcement.
