The total alkalinity of pool water shall be maintained between 60 and 180 ppm as calcium carbonate unless it can be shown that another level of total alkalinity produces chemically balanced water based on calculations approved by the department.</p> <p>Observed Violations - 26 - Permissible patron load, Rescue equipment, first aid equipment, telephone present, located,</p>

good condition, phone numbers posted

OBSERVATION: The first aid station has been approved to be located at the front desk along with signage that indicates this. The front desk staff were unaware of the location of the three biohazard cleanup kits that are available in the three linen storage rooms throughout the hotels.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Provide a biohazard safety kit at the first aid station. Or provide adequate training and signage to indicate the location of the bio hazard kits. Correct By: 25-Feb-2019

CODE CITATION: ATCP 76.27 First aid supplies. (2) Biohazard safety equipment, including a blood and biohazard disposal kit shall be located at the first aid station or another location on the premises approved by the department.

Observed Violations - 27 - Pool rules enforced - communicable disease, showers, food, glass, animals prohibited. Maximum patron loading posted, legible, located, Maximum pool attendance posted, closing criteria followed.

OBSERVATION: The "No Diving" and "No Lifeguard" sign requires 4" letters, but only has 4" capital and 3.5" lowercase.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Recommend printing signs with the required rules in bulleted format and in ALL CAPS. Correct By: 01-Jan-2020 Correct By: 01-Jan-2020 Correct By: 01-Jan-2020

CODE CITATION: WHIRLPOOLS. For whirlpools, the signage required under sub. (1) shall also be conspicuously posted in the whirlpool area

and include all of the following rules preceded by the word WARNING conspicuously printed in at least 1 inch letters:

- (a) Elderly persons and persons suffering from heart disease, diabetes, or high or low blood pressure should not enter the whirlpool.
- (b) Minors under the age of 12 who are unsupervised may not use the whirlpool.
- (c) Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs may not use the whirlpool.
- (d) Pregnant women should consult their physician regarding whirlpool usage.
- (e) Lengthy exposure may be hazardous to your health and may result in nausea, dizziness or fainting.
- (f) Minors under the age of 6 are not permitted in the whirlpool.

Observed Violations - 27 - Pool rules enforced - communicable disease, showers, food, glass, animals prohibited. Maximum patron loading posted, legible, located, Maximum pool attendance posted, closing criteria followed.

OBSERVATION: The letters on the pool rules signage are less than 1-inch in height. All letters on the signs with the pool and whirlpool rules must be 1" high. Currently the large rules sign have 1" capital and 3/4" lowercase letters. The small whirlpool rules sign have 1/2" letters.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Reprint the sign in compliance with ATCP 76.29(1)(b). Correct By: 01-Jan-2020 Correct By: 01-Jan-2020

CODE CITATION: ATCP 76.29 Posting pool and water attraction rules. (1) GENERAL. (b) A legible sign showing pool use rules shall be posted in a conspicuous place or places in the pool area. The sign shall include at least all of the rules in this paragraph in letters at least one inch high. Pool rules in connection with water attractions, therapy pools or other specialized pools defined in s. Comm 90 or this chapter may not be eliminated or modified without approval by the department.

1. Do not enter the pool if you have a communicable disease or an open cut.
2. Do not bring food, drink, gum or tobacco into the pool.
3. Shower before entering the pool and after use of toilet facilities.
4. Do not run or engage in rough play in the pool area.
5. Do not bring animals into the pool area.
6. Diaper changing on the pool deck is prohibited.
7. Glass and shatterable items are prohibited in the pool area.


