### **CALL TO ORDER**

### **CLOSED SESSION**

Stats., Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where Par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations), TO WIT: INTERVIEW INDIVIDUAL APPLICANTS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE. Motion carried unanimously.

Action taken in closed session showed five requests for financial assistance. Four applications were approved providing two grants for housing assistance, one for utilities and one for groceries. One applicant was denied as the Commission could not provide enough assistance to resolve financial problems. Motion by Sjolander to return to open session at 4:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
