### TJC INITIATIVE

The TJC consultants will be back here sometime in June. As part of the TJC Initiative, Coulee Cap has put aside five tenant based rental assistance vouchers for high risk, high needs people. These people need to have a mental illness because the funding requirements from TEBRA. Also, we have put aside some money to do the same thing (for approximately 5 people) for 18 months to 2 years for people who are primarily heavy substance abuse users or high risk, high needs, high users of the jail, etc.

There are number of staff and people from the State who will be attending an Offender Workforce Development Specialist Training (160 hours of training for 5-6 people locally).

### **REVIEW CITIZEN MEMBER TERM LIMITS**

Per the Ordinance, citizen members for the CJMC are appointed to 3 year terms and can only be on the council for 2 terms. Currently there are some citizen members that have been on the council longer than this. Jane will discuss with Steve Doyle, who is in charge of the appointments, and also discuss with the CJMC members who have been on for longer than 2 terms.

### SECRETARY HAMBLIN VISIT

Department of Corrections Secretary Gary Hamblin visited La Crosse to discuss Act 100 (the new OWI law changes). Also, the new COMPASS software was discussed. The training will be starting the second week in July.
