Tom Tornstrom Updated the Commission on Tri-State Ambulances Involvement Regarding the Tornado Touchdown In the City Of La Crosse.

Tri-State had 7 paramedic level ambulances available immediately and within minutes there were also 2 Paramedic Supervisors and 2 Tri-State Paramedic Managers. By 5:00 P.M. there were 17 ambulances committed to the system, 13 Tri-State owned and 4 mutual aid. In addition there were a total 22 staff members called in so in addition to the staff on duty which is 2/3 of the entire staff. In addition to the staffed ambulances there were 8 additional crew members brought down to the incident command post and available if needed. There was no loss of life, no storm related transports and only 5 minor injuries. Tom said, remarkably neither hospital had a storm related incidence during the storm or the hours following.

The Commission members present commended Tri-State on their efficiency and preparedness.
