#### ROLL CALL/CALL TO ORDER:

President Loren Caulum called the meeting to order at 4:49 pm.

### APPROVAL OF THE MEETING AGENDA:

MOTION by Benrud/Seager to approve the agenda as written. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Fred Marini passed around the award that was presented at a State ceremony in Madison by Tony Evers, State Superintendent of the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. Melrose-Mindoro School District won the State Superintendent's "Standing Up for Rural Wisconsin Schools, Libraries, and Community Award" for the "Bringing Community Library Services to Rural Wisconsin" project. On March 7th Chris McArdle Rojo, Ron Perry, Melrose-Mindoro Superintendent and Rita Cox, Friends of the Mindoro Community Library, Inc. joined Fred Marini, District Media Director/Librarian for Melrose-Mindoro Area School District in Madison for the reception and award ceremony. Local Village Chairmen, LeRoy Craig and Mike Hesse were unable to attend.

George Varnum shared that he had utilized State Interlibrary Loan services for the first time and was very impressed with Sue Stranc for all her great help in finding the out of print materials he was looking for in his research.

## WRLS REPORT:

Caulum and McArdle Rojo reported that WRLS has a new director. Kristen Anderson will start work on April 18th following David's retirement. After the first round of interviews failed to find a candidate, Kristen was unanimously named Director at the March 23rd WRLS Board meeting. She is well-liked and respected in the Region and member directors look forward to working with her. McArdle Rojo will extend an invitation for Anderson to join us at an upcoming meeting. Caulum also shared that auditors reported that WRLS is fiscally healthy and McArdle Rojo announced that there is currently a vacancy on the WRLS Board and any suggestions or nominations can be forwarded to her or to County Board Chairman Steve Doyle's office.

## FACILITY, COMMUNITY, & PROGRAMMING UPDATES:

A report was included in the Board packets. Additional information included the recent move of the Onalaska donor shelf to the main wall in the library making the piece much more noticeable.

Youth Services Staff were honored with a "Friend of Education Award" by the Onalaska School District. The Onalaska Kindergarten Center nominated the Team for their collaborative work and partnership with the District. Manthei suggested that the award be re-recognized in the fall with our annual Awards ceremony to continue to highlight the partnership we support with our area school districts.

Benrud reported on her visit with Governor Walker at a State Transportation Conference last month in Wisconsin Dells. She passed on our requests to the Governor.

Krieg-Sigman, La Crosse County Library Director, will be the Chair of the Wisconsin Library Association's Annual Conference when it returns to La Crosse October 23-26, 2012. She will be seeking volunteers as the time nears.

### FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:

McArdle Rojo indicated that County Administrator Steve O'Malley will reschedule his visit to a future Library Board meeting. He continues his diligent work to support the County during the upcoming State budget hearings and to defend County programs during this difficult time.
