## Wildlife Damage Program: January

1) Shooting Permit Harvest Exemption: consideration

Ted Dovenberg

- Issued WM-40 shooting permit on January 18, 2011
- Harvest Objective = 15 deer (80% harvest quota by September  $15^{th} = 12$ )
- Actual Harvest by Sept.  $15^{th} = 8$  deer

<u>Recommendation</u>: Based on confusion regarding an increased harvest quota from preceding years (Mr. Dovenberg believed his 80% quota was 8 deer, which he met) and his previous shooting permit performance, DNR and WS would recommend granting a harvest exemption.

Wolf – The delisting rule was published in the Federal Register on December 28, 2011(*requires 30 day waiting period*). On January 27, 2012 the gray wolf was officially delisted from the Endangered Species Act. On that date, Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin took over management of the species (assumes no future litigation)???
